

February 1941

- Fri 7 20 Above the morning, cold all day, and wind from the North. Very cloudy this evening and looks like snow. A dance to night in town.
- Sat 8 22 Above this this morning, very mild towards noon and blowing a West wind. I drove over and got the mail after noon. roads are good.
- Sun 9 A fine clear day and very mild.
- Mon 10 22, Above this morning, Fred hauling fire wood for Johnny, tractor pulling sleds & caulkers passed here to night on their way to Kelson they are going to cut the road and expect to get through before the snow goes off. so above to night.
- Tue 11 21 Above this morning, wind from north a light fall of snow this evening, but cleared up later.
- Wed 12 5 Above this morning, Fred got the mail. Very mild all day a little colder towards evening.
- Thur 13 A fine mild day. A number of trucks hauling freight from Dawson Creek to Helderup for the road party. Fred went to Ranch to see the horses. Very, clear and mild to night.
