Fry 14 Very mild all day Fred went over to 24 Ranch to fix up the fence as the horses had broke into the stacks and destroyed some the sheaves. J. Halway ~~was~~ was helping him. a dance to night in town, blowing a strong west wind to night

Sat 15 12 Above this morning mild all day I drove over and got the mail. McLeod's team got back from Sakuma they brought Bonanza, with a bad frog his bad he is now in the hospital

Sun 16 A fine warm day

Mon 17 28 Above this morning very mild all day Fred took some mail to the Post Office very mild this evening

Tue 18 24 Above this morning cold and stormy all day Fred went over and fixed the fence at 24 R. Snowed a little toward evening and a cold East wind. 2 more tractors passed on their way North to night

Wed 19 Cold and stormy with snow this morning very little doing Fred drove over to town and got the mail. Still stormy to night with snow to night Wind from North 5 below zero
