- Frid 7 30 above this morning and blizzing
A Warm Southwest wind thawing
most of the day a few light showers
of rain this evening
- Sat 8 26 above and Very thawed a little about
noon Fred got the mail
- Sun 9 A fine clear day thawed towards
noon
