Tue 11 4 above this morning but very mild all day. Fred went over to 24 R and fed the horses. A number of trucks passing with freight for Ft. Nelson.

Wed 12 Weather fine, very mild, thawed a little. Fred went over and got the mail.

Thu 13 Continues fine mild weather, thawing around the buildings. Fred sawing firewood at John's place.

Fri 14 18 above this morning, mild but very little thaw. Frost came this evening. A cold north wind to night and turned very cold and clear.

Sat 15 10 below zero this morning, snowed a little during last night. Continued cold all day, cloudy to night and a cold north wind. A report is that the road party, are 20 miles from Ft. Nelson. The trucks are hauling freight from Dawson Creek to Sakinna River. They make that in one day from here.

Sun 16 A fine mild day.
