Mon 17 4 Above this Morning snowed during the night and continued all day. Fred took some mail to the Post Office. St Patrick day dance to night in town still snowing to night and blowing a North East Wind

Tue 18 A fine clear day, thawed a little in the afternoon blowing a North Wind and a little colder towards evening

Wed 19 16 Above this Morning and fine all day. A tractor pulling 3 big sleds with freight passed here on its way to Ft Nelson at Noon. Fred went for the Mail Very Mild and clear to night

Thu 20 18 Above this Morning Very Mild All day. Fred sawing fire wood at Johns. A few trucks running

Fri 21 Very Mild and warm all day. A warm West Wind this evening. Fred came home this evening from Johns place. 42 Above, few to night
