Fri 28 Blowing a strong West Wind all day
3 sled tracks passed here on their
way to Port Nelson a lot of snow
gone the highway is all mud
Toed came back from Yukon to right
where he has been during week

Sat 29 A hard frost last night but very warm
all day I drove over for the mail but did
not get in but may get this evening
the snow all gone on the highway
and the road is fine and dry

Sun 30 Snowing this morning and blowing
a strong north wind cold all day

Mon 31 16 Above this morning but very clear
and cold wind from North

April 1941

Tue 1 26 Above this morning cloudy
and overcast blowing a cold
North East Wind a report that
the mail could not get through
with the freight on account of the snow
gone they turned and got him last night
