Sun 13 A fine clear day, the Plains  
all left

Mon 14 Weather <sup>fine</sup> I was working in the  
Garden Duncan. Went to Dawson Creek.  
Fred hauling fence Posts

Tue 15 Blowing a cold North Wind Fred cleared  
out the well I planted some Cabbage seed x  
this morning very cloudy all day

Wed 16 fine this morning but started to blow  
a cold North wind about noon I drove  
over and got the mail, the ferry reported  
to be running and trucks crossing it today  
a dance at Thorsens hall to night

Thu 17 A fine clear day and very warm all day  
I was fixing up the bed and working  
in the garden. Fred cutting fire wood  
at Johns place

Fri 18 weather fine I was busy in the garden  
and some seeds in the hot bed Duncan  
moved to top of the hill at 2 P.M. Frank went  
for a visit to Mikkelsen, Fred came  
back to night from Johns place

Sat 19 Weather fine we was busy cleaning up and  
burning around the place I drove over and  
got the mail in the afternoon Frank got back  
from Mikkelsen and Berley this evening  
very cloudy to night
