- Mon 23 Blowing a cold N. & Wind with snow
this morning I drove over with some
mail to the Post Office Duncan, but
a load of fire wood
- Tue 24 Snow this morning cleared up, but soon
started to snow again this evening
blow from north
- Wed 25 Christmas Day Snowed a little this morning
we had a few visitors for dinner snowed
again this evening
- Thu 26 A fine clear day the Soldier that came home
for a brief left this evening Angus went
along with him he is going to join up Duncan
but a load of wood
- Fri 27 cold this morning Duncan hauled a load of wood
- Sat 28 10 below this morning clear and cold all day I drove
over and got the mail
- Sun 29 20 below this morning but all day
- Mon 30 30 below cold all day with snow cleared up this evening
- Tue 31 24 below this morning very cold all day
a dense fog in town below at 9 to night
