- Wed 11th 28 Above this morning. Very mild and blowing
a west wind. We drove over and got the mail
- Thurs 12th 30 Above this morning. Fired drove over to
to split fire wood to Duncan who is staying here
Very mild all day
- Frid 13th 28 Above this morning and night. Still mild. Fired
splitting fire wood. Very mild all day
- Sat 14th 10 Above this morning. Blowing a strong N.E. wind

came over for a visit.
