April 1942

Wed 1 Very mild this morning I was busy about 10 AM Angus went for the mail but on account of ^{bad} road it did not get here until very late to night

Thur 2 Blowing a strong West Wind the U.S. Men are moving to Mr. Pickle's field where they are making a camp. a number of them have gone to Ft. Nelson

Fri 3 Blowing a cold North Wind with snow cleared up in the afternoon but very cold

Sat 4 A hard frost last night and cold all day I was over and got the mail this morning this evening a few showers of snow to night
