- Sat 9 A few showers this morning and very cold. Cloudy and overcast. We got the mail in the afternoon. August Wells packing for Maclellan.
- Sun 10 A fine clear day. Mrs. McNeilson and one of her boys came for a visit.
- Mon 11 Tried to send mail to the Post Office this morning and started to blow after dinner. Cloudy and overcast. A few showers towards evening.
- Tue 12 Frost last night but a fine clear day. I was busy working in the garden. Blowing a cold wind at night.
- Wed 13 Cold this morning but fine and clear all day. I drove to town with some mail. Fred Pearson Duncan arrived this evening. S. W. Ross, who is reported to have disappeared, is coming back to town.
- Wed 15 Frost last night. Fred finished plowing and I finished part of the field. I planted a few potatoes. A few showers this evening.
- Sat 16 Cold last night. Cloudy and overcast. We drove over and the mail.
- Sun 17 A fine warm day.
