JUNE THURSDAY 9 (189-205) 1904

Splendid day Self started to the look
of hope not to be around with the
Indians coming around
Self & Samson still at police finished
this afternoon & started to put up fine
little train

FRIDAY 10 (189-204)

Pat & Samson and putting up fine Self and
flowers from end of road
Had a heavy shower of hail & then
rained hard for hours of the afternoon
it did a lot of good to the garden

SATURDAY 11 (188-203)

Went digging holes for some work
Samson & Arnold gave me some work
General Self & Arnold
Sunday
Very warm & hot & Samson off
cards on a boat run
