and blowing a south wind I was busy,
cutting weeds in the field.
Treats paid to Indians today
- Wed 15 A fine clear day, I drove over and got the mail
I was busy in the garden, Very hot all day
cloudy towards evening
- Thurs 16 A heavy fog this morning I was busy in the garden
Very hot this afternoon
- Fri 17 Cloudy this morning, cleared up toward noon
Duncan arrived from the Road party where
he has been all summer he will be going
back in a few days
- Sat 18 A fine clear day, and very hot the Duncans
came over for dinner I drove over with
them to town Commissioner Bassett came in
from Victoria and came over for a visit
- Sun 19 A very hot day I drove over with mail
this morning
- Mon 20 A fine clear day, very hot towards noon
I was busy in the garden and did jobs
cloudy this evening
- Tue 21 A thunderstorm with heavy rain and wind
this morning, which was a good thing as
the ground was getting very dry
- Wed 22 A fine clear day and very hot Duncan
left this morning to join the U.S. Road
party
