- Wed 12 Cloudy and overcast this morning, but cleared up towards noon and very hot. John but the mail - cold to night - Fred started work.
- Tue 13 Cold during the night - blowing a strong West Wind and very warm.
- Tue 14 A fine clear day blowing a West Wind and a lot of smoke. But some best fires south west of here. John but the mail it had come in to day.
- Sat 15 I drove to town this morning. Very hot and the roads very rough and full of dust. There is a big show in town to night.
- Sun 16 Blowing a strong West Wind all day.
- Mon 17 A fine clear day blowing a strong West Wind. Fred took the Buggy to the Blacksmith this morning to get the wheels fixed. I started to cut oats for Fred at John's place. Fred busy starting.
- Tue 18 Still blowing a strong West Wind. Fred a before cloud towards evening.
- Wed 19 Cold during last night but fine this morning. Fred as before and finished. It started to rain this evening and continued nearly all night. The heaviest rain we have had this morning.
- Thurs 20 A fine clear morning. The garden looks good after the rain. Cloudy to night and Rained some about midnight.
- Fri 21 Cold this morning rained during the night and very hot all day.
