

September 1942

- Tue 1 Rained heavy during the night and this morning cleared up about 10 this morning and blowing a strong North Wind. Fred starting the Oct
- Wed 2 A hard frost last night Fred at 10 o'clock he went for the mail towards evening
- Thu 3 A fine clear day Fred starting and finished Fred got 2 young pigs
- Fri 4 Frost during the night but a fine morning clear day Fred at wood
- Sat 5 A fine clear day and they got the drive over and got the mail a number of people in town
- Sun 6 Rained heavy early this morning but cleared up about day light
- Mon 7 Labor day Fred helping Hanson stacking. A fine clear day 3 miners left by Plator to Crosscut on the upper Peace River. Cloudy this evening
- Tue 8 Started to rain early this morning and rained most of the day. Very little doing.
- Wed 9 cloudy and overcast a few heavy showers cleared up in the afternoon Fred got the mail
- Thu 10 A fine clear day Fred starting at Hanson
- Fri 11 A fine clear day Fred as before
- Sat 12 cold last night but a fine clear day blowing a strong West Wind we drove over and got the mail Duncan arrived from Ft Nelson with his high horse
