- Sat 26 Frost last night. I was busy at odd jobs. We went to town for a few supplies. but no mail. Very warm all day. Duncan came in for a short time and off again.
- Sun 27 A fine clear day. A few Blains left for the North. Very warm all day.
- Mon 28 A fine clear day. Fred working at Angus place. Angus left with McCutcher's post outfit to work on a new road near Sekhona River.
- Tue 29 A hard frost this morning. We put vegetation in the ciller. Frank helping.
- Wed 30 Cold and cloudy this morning. We was busy fixing our meat freezer. And at odd jobs. Cold this evening.
