Tue 19 A hard frost this morning. Cloud and overcast. Wind from South.

Wed 20 A fine clear day. John beat the mail had a visit from Fred Mordeth of Hudson Bay.

Thurs 21 Cold and stormy. Wind S.W. cloudy towards evening.

Fri 22 A hard frost last night snowed a little this morning. I put some Calig. in the Post house. Very cold this evening.
