Mon 21 A fine clear day. John bus the mail. Had a visit from Fred Montfort of Redon Hope.

Tue 22 Cold and stormy. Wind SW. Cloud, towards evening.

Wed 23 A hard frost last night. Snowed a little this morning. I put some Calumet in the Post house. Very cold this evening.
