North East wind. Frank left to join
his doghouse at Vancouver, B.C.

Wed 22 2 Below zero this morning. Cold all day. Was
dry during the hour.

Thu 23 7 Below this morning, blowing a cold
North West with snow. Fred cutting firewood
at Thurston.

Fri 24 10 Below this morning and a cold North
Wind. Fred as before. Willie helping. Then
8 Below to night.

Sat 25 25 Below zero this morning but a fine clear
day. Fred cutting wood. Cold and stormy to night.

Sun 26 8 Snow and blowing a cold North wind. The
snow was Birly and Harol.

Mon 27 10 Below zero this morning. Snowed about 1/2
during the night. Fred cutting firewood.
Willie came over and camped.

December 1942

Tue 1 18 below this morning but a fine clear day.
Fred cutting firewood.

Wed 2 24 Below this morning. Cold and clear all day.
Fred as before.
