Mon	7	29 Below this morning and a cold North wind. Tried cutting fire wood turned very mild this evening.
Tues	8	2 Below this morning and a light fall of snow. Tried as before. Willie went over to the farm.
Wed	9	29 Below this morning and a cold North wind. Tried cutting fire wood turned very mild this evening.
Thurs	10	4 Below this morning. Tried as before. 20 Above zero this evening.
Frid	11	36 Above in this morning. Tried cutting wood. Wind from West rained this evening.
Sat	12	A fine clear morning and very mild. Tried cutting wood. We drove to for a few supplies after dinner.
Sun	13	A fine clear day but cold. The family came over for a visit.
Mon	14	Cloudy and overcast this morning. Tried cutting fire wood.
