- Fri 18 22 Below this morning and cold all day.

- Sat 19 22 below this morning. Blowing a cold
North Wind. 20 below to night and very cloudy.
- Sun 20 10 below this and snowing. About 4 in
of snow during the night, cleared up towards
noon.
- Mon 21 20 below a fine clear day. Fred cutting fire wood.
Duncan got back from his trip north.
- Tue 22 snowing this morning, and a west wind.
Fred as before. 24 below to night.
- Wed 23 23 below this morning. Wind from East.
Fred cutting fire wood.
- Thu 24 Cold and stormy. Blowing a cold North East
Wind.
- Fri 25 Christmas Day. We all went over to John's place
for dinner at 12:30. 35 below 20 below this morning
and was cold all day. We had
John's family and the boys here for dinner.
