- Mon 22 Passed zero this morning Fred working at
the saw camp
- Tue 23 Day mild cloudy and overcast Fred as before
- Wed 24 Continued fine weather thawing towards evening
Most of the snow gone Fred as before
- Thurs 25 A fine clear day busy at all jobs Fred as before
- Fri 26 Another fine day Fred as before
thawing in the afternoon snow nearly all gone
- Sat 27 A little colder wind from north
Fred and I drove over to town
- Sun 28 Started to snow this morning, wind from north
Fred working, Duncan came over for
a visit cleared towards noon
