Thu 9 A light frost this morning a fine clear day Blowing
a strong west wind a big fire started behind the house
Fred as before

Fri 10 A fine clear day Fred as before started work

Sat 11 A frost last night cold and clear this morning
Fred as before we drove to town this evening

Sun 12 Blowing a strong west wind

Mon 13 A fine clear day self digging potatoes in the
Garden a strong west wind Fred as before

Tue 14 Cloudy this morning self digging potatoes
Fred as before very cold to night

Wed 15 A hard frost this morning we drove to town
Fred as before

Thu 16 I drove over to Aro and helped Susan stacking oats
The Government of Canada ordered by Plain from Alaska
I came back late this evening
