 in from the garden 14 sacks
- Sat 25 A fine warm day the farmers busy thrashing
 Fred fixing the fence we drove to town this evening
- Sun 26 Cloudy and overcast Fred working at Smith's corner
- Mon 27 Blowing a strong West wind Fred as before
 Mrs B Cameron's child in the Hospital today
- Tue 28 A fine clear day a strong West wind Fred as before
 fine burning North and South of here
- Wed 29 Blowing a strong West wind and cold Fred as before
 Duncan left with his back to him to Black Creek this morning
