- Wed 6 A fine clear day, blowing a strong  
west wind.
- Thu 7 Very mild still blowing a strong west wind.  
I drove to R24 to see Duncan horses.
- Fri 8 A fine clear day very hot and lots of smoke, bush  
fires burning north of here.
- Sat 9 continues very fine weather. We drove over  
to town after dinner, blowing a strong west wind.
- Sun 10 A hard frost this morning, but fine all day.  
Very cloudy to night and cold.
- Mon 11 Rained during the night and started to snow this morning.  
Thawing during day cleared up towards noon.
- Tue 12 A hard frost this morning and a heavy fog.  
Cleared towards noon very cold this evening.
- Wed 13 Rained a little during the night a heavy fog  
this morning, cleared up towards noon.
- Thu 14 Cold and clear this morning, blowing a west wind.  
Duncan got back this evening.
