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Sat 12 Rained early this Morning
cloudy and overcast and a few showers
Some farmers started to cut their wheat

Sun 13 A heavy fog this morning cleared up
towards noon

Mon 14 A fine clear morning clouded towards
evening and started to rain
Wind from South West

Tue 15 Rained during the night but cleared up
this morning blowing a North Wind

Wed 16 A heavy fog this morning & Mr Diddy
of the H.B. returned this morning and
left by train for Victoria where he is
going to stay

Thur 17 Rained during the night a heavy fog this
morning cleared towards noon

Fri 18 Cloudy and a light rain this morning
and a few showers in the afternoon

Sat 19 Clear this morning we drove to town
for a few supplies. Cloudy towards evening
and a few heavy showers

Sun 20 A few showers

Mon 21 A heavy fog this morning but cleared
up towards noon

Tue 22 A fine clear day Fred and family
moved to his homestead
