 but cleared up at day light  
 cold all day very cloudy towards  
 evening

Monday 4<sup>th</sup>  
 Larkspur day self very busy  
 Prairie & Simpson in morning  
 very cloudy all day a few Indian  
 around trail gathering some passed  
 through in a canoe at noon  
 Mr Moore Sub Agent & Party  
 from Pine Lake passed up  
 the Prairie in this day to Hope  
 this evening

Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup>  
 Weather fine but cold towards  
 evening a lot of Indians around  
 Mr Moore Sub Agent arrived and  
 camped at Mr Barber's self very  
 busy all day Pine Lake still cold
