Cold & stormy with snow all day  
self at wood pile keep hauling  
Hay

Saturday 6  
self at wood pile the boys at wood  
a fine mild day Mr Bailey of  
Perillous & Constable Parsons left 8 days  
for Hudsons Hope at noon

Sunday 7  
Steamer a severe blizzard missed  
all day self went down to Philip  
with the steamer Yakatzie & others  
arrived from the north

Monday 8  
Continues blowing a lot of snow  
gone self busy with Indians  
they left after dinner for their  
camps 4 days from here

Tuesday 9  
a fine clear day continues warm  
self packing furs the boys went  
for a trip of Hay  
Kamsuok came up  
from the flat for his sleds George  
went down with him they are going  
to Power Camp for coal

Wednesday 10  
a fine mild day self packing  
furs Taylor up from the flat  
4 men arrived from H. Hope on  
business regarding their land  
a strong north wind started  
blowing & a black alarm with  
snow and turned very cold

Thursday 11  
a fine clear day but cold self coming  
up for furs. The H. Hope men left  
today for home
