Tuesday 16

a fine clear day Mr. Baillerman in office self helping Johnny after noon J. Hanley left for Spirit River taking the N. B. train alone

Wednesday 17

weather fine self at odd jobs Mr. Baillerman busy but not feeling very well. Cookhouse & Magazine started another run across the river cloudy and looks like snow

Thursday 18

a fine clear day self & Mr. Baillerman very busy a lot of people arrived waiting for the mail but it did not arrive
