Friday 19

Cold & stormy all day busy as yesterday. Messengers Bay & 2 others with letters arrived from Ft Hope on their way to Spunk River.

Saturday 20

Cold & stormy self at old jobs. Mr Bartleman very busy still. No mail.

Sunday 21

Very cold 48 below this morning. The mail arrived and left us about 2 hours after.

Monday 22

Self & Mr Bartleman in office. Mr Sykes H.B. has buyers and from Edmonton by way of Grande Prairie. Started to move towards evening.

Tuesday 23

Self very busy. Mr Sykes looking over the fur. A fine clear day. Process left for Spunk River.

Wednesday 24

A fine clear day. Mr Sykes & Mr. [unclear] left for Ft Hope this morning. Self at old jobs. Mr Bartleman rather sick.

Thursday 25

Mr Bartleman left along with George & Birdy for Peace Camp. This morning snow nearly all day. Self at old jobs a team of 3 men passed up the River but did not stop.
