his report. The boys hauling
firewood. Self in store. Cloudy
and looks like snow.

Friday 23

Blowing a strong gale of wind
from the west. Self & the boys
cutting firewood. Big Charlie
& 3 Indian boys arrived from
Leyard & Lake and brought a
few furs.

Saturday 24

Cold and stormy. Washburn &
Jahraie arrived and brought some
furs. Self busy with Indians.

Sunday 25

A fine clear day. Kasper seen
this morning. The Pouce
Coupe Manager arrived from
Pouce Coupe. The Indians left
this morning.
