Monday 26

Self busy in office still blowing
a strong Chinook wind the snow
all gone up the Hills but there is
very little snow in the bush
A white man came from up
the Halpury River and brought a
few furs which he sold to Remellous
Macfie for \$100.00
A fisher from King for \$70.00

Tuesday 27

Cold and stormy with snow
in store The Prince Rupert
left for home this morning

Wednesday 28

Cold & stormy Self out cutting
fire wood Mr. Ogden had
a son this evening

Thursday 29

Cold & stormy with snow
all day very cold.

Friday 30

Continues very stormy Self in
office the Day Painter fine
wood from the Island

Saturday 31

A little milder today 3 miners
arrived from Antelope on their
way to the mountains cold towards
evening

Sunday April 1st 1917

A fine clear day 2 Indians
arrived from the north
and report a very good hunt
