A fine clear day self busy
clearing up around the place
Peter and from out there
camp they are camped at Cack
Creek and it looks as if they
had gone thru the river broke
up and the ice went out

Friday 4

self as yesterday a lot of ice
still going down. continues
fine and warm the Boon
man had a colt today

Saturday 5

self in office a lot of people
around as it was mail day
the mail arrived towards evening
still a lot of ice going down

Sunday 6 May 1917

A fine clear day self went up
the hill to Johns household
to see the boys. I also went
over to the Prussian and bought
Johns Pikes & Cattle for 175⁰⁰

Monday 7

self & Seage planted potatoes
in the upper field planted
4 sacks a lot of ice went down
this evening. Made a bundle
M B Prady also arrived from
Halfway River

Tuesday 8

continues fine got Prady to
cut a fancy stool. I also put
in a little oats in the upper
field a lot of trees having
cell around
