down 2 men arrived looking
for land Mr Turpin fire Prosser
here

Friday 11

Self at ad jobs weather fine
C. Payette & another man passed
down the River also 2 men went
down on a raft River still rising

Saturday 12

Cold & stormy with rain all day
Self in office Madest patched off
2 Indians came in from Adress
Camp River falling a little

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Sunday 13

Self went up the hill
attachie & his band arrived also
old Pakatatie & 3 boys from
up the N River Rain nearly
all day

Monday 14

Self busy with Indians
Most of them said their raft
& men passed down in a canoe
from up the River a fine
clear day Cloudy towards
evening

Tuesday 15

Rain all day Self at ad jobs
a raft with 3 men left this
morning for P. H. for

as small

Pratt arrived from P. H. with
the Dr. and Survey Party one
around this evening
