

May 1917

Wednesday 16

The business went left for the Hupla
this morning. Self in store
went to get his outfit as usual
and put in their Pans. The Sunday
Party put up their tents and fixing
up their axes & supplies. Rain
nearly all day. The little boat
got back this evening making the round
trip in the day.

Thursday 17

Outdoors & a few others arrived
and paid their debts. Self by bus
to Green & family arrived from N. Hupla
on a boat at 11 P.M. The boat
left this morning for P.R. trip.

Friday 18

A fine clear day. The Indians left
for home this evening. Self put in
a few potatoes. Rain coming
fast.

Saturday 19

Continued fine & lot of people
arrived. Still no mail. The
Mammoth Rock train came in
this evening.

Sunday 20

Still no mail. Mammoth Rock
outfit left this evening.

Monday 21

Self at old jobs & lot of Indians
arrived. They are camped at
Fish Creek. The mail has not
yet arrived.

Tuesday 22

Self planted a few potatoes & brought
2 white men arrived from the
Mammoth. They brought a lot of things.
I brought three Lynx & fish.
Always to be seen every night
a little rain. Still no mail.
