the river falling

Still no mail

A fine clear day self busy
asked the place H. Leadwood
arrived from P. Prince with
basalium canoe

Sunday 27

Cadenhead left for home
a Government party arrived with
a small boat from P. Prince
they are overhauled the river
and going up to look at the
barriers. Claude & Luke
like mine

Monday 28

Prison & Snow this morning
self in office. River Prince
fast still no mail

Tuesday 29

Self busy in store a few Indians
arrived. The Appassion
arrived from Port Prince
Prison still coming up
a heavy frost last night
which froze the potatoes
Still no mail
