Very hot self in office
the S.S. Pine Pass arrived
from up the South Pine
2 passengers wanting to
go down on her

Wednesday 11

a warm day the Pine Pass
left this morning water
quarry during frost

Thursday 12

crater fine clear day
evening a P.B. Road train
arrived and left for
H. Hope
