self at odd jobs

Thursday 19

Very hot all day the River
was on a flood from K Hope
canoe left for Cooks Bay Camp
very successful there must be
big fish somewhere up
the river

Friday 20

a fine clear day 3 mines arrived
from K Hope on their way to P.P. King
self in garden hoeing potatoes
