Friday 28

blowing a strong gale up West Wind
the S.S. Macbeth passed down
the River at noon having made the
trip up as far as Birds Landing

Saturday 29

Big fires burning all around the
Country and no one looking after
it self & the only went up the hill to see
if they may see in any danger but as yet
it is all safe blowing a strong gale
of West Wind

Sunday 30 1917

a fine clear day
the mail left this morning
self out fighting fires

October 1917

Monday 1

continues fine weather
self very busy around the Place

Tuesday 2

self in office blowing a strong
gale of wind started to rain
at noon good continued until
about 7 P.M. it will put out the
fires

Wednesday 3

self in office a fine clear day

Thursday 4

a fine clear day self & wife
putty Potatoes in Ciller 5 inches
around and repair the death of
letty Judge Probertson a well
known & hope
