Judge Robertson left this morning
for Prince George

Monday 8

Mr. Brewster arrived last night
the Pine Pass passed down the river
self at odd jobs

Tuesday 9

blowing strong gale the river
still rising up self at odd
jobs the boys put away the
potatoes up at the ranch they
had over 60 sacks

1917

Wednesday 10 October
cloudy & overcast looked like
rain or snow self in office
Pine dropping

Thursday 11

Mr. Brewster leaving party arrived
on train very wet self in
store Mr. Nicholson & party passed down
the river

Friday 12

Cold & storming self very busy
the S.S. Lady Macintosh arrived from
the river and continued on to
Nicol's place

Saturday 13

the S.S. Macintosh arrived and took
Mr. Brewster & party on board and
continued on her way down
a fine clear day Pine rising on
the top of the hill

Sunday 14

a fine clear day old mountains and
from Mores Lake Pine turned
evening
