Wednesday 24 October
Continues fine the Indians all
packed up. Attaches moved gone to
Hedon's Hope to get Dept from
McDonough. Self at odd jobs
the river falling the Police left for
Pence Camp this morning

Thursday 25
Continued cold all day with a light
fall of snow in the evening
Self at odd jobs River clear of ice

Friday 26
Self in store and at odd jobs
Coldly and over cast all day
started to snow towards evening

Saturday 27
Cold & stormy with snow all day
Self at odd jobs boys working up
the buildings. Horse shod a York
crossing the river

Sunday 28 October 1917
Snowed all day. Men out looking
for horses. Hunters arrived
with their dogs in the
South side. They are leaving their
horses with Philip for the night

Monday 29
Blowing chinook wind snow
nearly all gone self in store
3 Indians arrived from Montague
camp. They report the death
of Denis Swan Child
2 men arrived on a raft this evening
a lot of ice running

Tuesday 30
continues warm self at odd jobs
around the place snow nearly
all gone the Police got back from
Pence Camp

Wednesday 31
Continues fine snow all gone and
no ice Self at odd jobs around
the place
