Friday

Self in office the mail arrived

nearly all the Settlers came in
for their mail

Saturday 10

The mail left this morning for
Pine Camp & the day weather fine
for this time of year self went
out and Planted this afternoon
water falling

Sunday 11

a fine mild day

Monday 12

continues very fine weather
Self fixing up the stable for
winter the River rising
The young saul arrived from
the South side

Tuesday 13

continues very fine weather
Self at old jobs 2 Indians
arrived and brought a few furs
and paid their Dept. River River

Wednesday 14

continues fine self busy with
Indians the Indians left this
evening after getting their
supplies

Thursday 15

continues fine 2 Appressians came
in from the South River for a few
supplies and left again Clancy
this evening and looks like snow

Friday 16

Very mild but cloudy and looks
like a change in the weather
the River still high Self at
old jobs the boys handling hay
