Saturday 24 November 1917

The mail left this morning  
quite a bit of snow, but fine and  
clear to day. The River falling  
help in office

Sunday 25

a fine clear day blowing a strong  
west wind. Big Charlie & 2  
others arrived from Charlie Lake  
and brought a few furs

Monday 26

Self busy with Indians. Charles  
arrived left. Joe Appassisen and  
this evening and brought a few  
furs. Cloud & looks like snow

Tuesday 27

weather fine. Antislens & 2 others  
arrived from the north and brought  
a few furs. He reports the death  
of old Appan being killed by a falling  
tree. Self busy with Indians.

Wednesday 28

Self busy with Indians. Cloudy  
& overcast a cold north wind towards  
evening. The Indians left for  
home this evening. Looks like winter

Thursday 29

Blowing a strong north wind with  
snow all day. River full of ice  
The Buzz handling hay.

Friday 30

Continues cold & stormy with  
snow all day. The River full of ice  
Self clearing up the store. Took  
the cattle in and started to feed  
them to day.
