Self busy with Indians
5 More arrived today they have
killed very little fur Mr Reid
the trader has been down at
the Club but I hear he has got
very little furs

Wednesday 2

Continues warm self busy with
Indians a few wolves around
the boys went for a caribou
hay the head of the Indians
left for their camp the deer
are around and went up to
look for his horses

Thursday 3rd

Mild very cloudy started to
snow towards evening

Friday 4 1918

Self in office bookkeeper brought
up some furs and put them up for
sale Reid brought in for a big price
\$745⁰⁰ The mail arrived

Saturday 5

The mail arrived from Hope
the mail carrier left this morning
but left the mail as it was not ready
in time a little colder today I Thomas
arrived from Hudsons Hope on his
way out to enlist

Sunday 6

Continues very mild weather

Monday 7

Self and the boys packing furs
made 3 packs to be shipped out by
Coasthead a fine mild day but
started to snow towards evening
for appraisement and for a few
supplies
