 continues very cold so below this morning  
 Self in office George hauling fire wood  
 a little milder towards evening

Thursday 31  
 a fine mild day Self & George went  
 for a load of Hay. Cloudy towards  
 evening & looks like snow

February 1 1918  
 Snow all day Self in office  
 George at wood  
 I heard today that Mr. Smith's  
 wife had a son and it died about  
 an hour after birth

Saturday February 2  
 a fine mild day Self in office  
 George went for a load of Hay

Sunday 3  
 Cold & stormy all day with snow  
 we all went up to the Ranch for dinner  
 The Deep Indian arrived from the  
 north and reports lots of snow but  
 very little frost. The H. Hope Chief died  
 this morning news came by wire

Monday 4  
 Self & George went for a load of  
 Hay blowing a strong gale of west  
 wind very mild

Tuesday 5  
 a fine mild after the storm which  
 raged all night it was a strong gale  
 of north wind all night  
 Self in office  
 The Duggs at wood
