Cold & stormy with snow self
at old jobs snow now almost
2 1/2 ft deep George went for Hay

Wednesday 13

Continues cold & stormy Self at
old jobs Ogilvie and I went up
to the Branch and cut the Hares
off the grey cow. Mr Muncey
arrived from Charlie Lake and sold
his Hares to Bevilan for \$742⁰⁰ My bid
was \$638⁰⁰

Thursday 14

Continues Cold George went for
a load of Hay Self at old jobs
Hares passed down for his bid
of \$638 which he left at the Branch

Friday 15

Continues Cold 35° below this morning
Self went out to look for Birch for
one bundle The Boys at school

Saturday 16

Continues Cold 40° below this morning
Very little doing Boys at school

Sunday 17

Continues cold & clear
The Macdonalds Boys arrived
with a team on their way to
Spent River they camped at the Police
Branches

Monday 18

Continues cold 20° below this morning
but mild towards evening Self
at old jobs

Tuesday 19

Continues cold George went for Hay
Hares arrived Cammick passed
up with a load of Hay for his bid
Self at old jobs
