Sunday 5

a few shrikes all day
or cut up for going down
Kenny went up to his hummock
to put in his trap

Monday 6

Self & Johnny planted potatoes and
put in 2nd fish. The mail arrived
this evening in bad shape as the
cove upset in the line and mail
all out our moon cow calmed this
evening

Tuesday 7

Menton arrived and paid
his debt. They have put out
fish traps. Self hung in stream
Johnny putting in potatoes
The water falling very cold night

Wednesday 8

Continued fine. Darius arrived and
paid his debt. Self and John
the Lady Mackintosh arrived from
Plover this evening

Thursday 9
The Lady Mackintosh left for N Hope
about nine a.m. Self & Johnny
hauled up the Knight. Japane
arrived and paid his debt.
Self went up to Kenny place
and sowed some oats

Friday 10

weather fine Self & Johnny planted
3 sacks potatoes up at the house
in the morning. Self and John
in afternoon. The Lady Mackintosh
arrived from N Hope this evening
and camped here

Saturday 11

The Lady Mackintosh left this
morning for Plover. Self in
office

Sunday 12

a fine clear day very warm
birds rising
