continues very cold self in office
a hard frost last night

Friday 17

continues cold & stormy and
from N & self in store a lot
of Indians around this evening
the mail arrived by canoe from
Cul. Bank Creek

Saturday 18

self busy with Indians the mail
left this morning

The Indians left
this evening for home they killed
a lot of Beavers and all paid
their debt

Sunday 19

Cold & stormy with a few showers

Monday 20

a big snow storm this morning
and continued during the day the
river falling fast self in office
John & Angus went up to
plant potatoes at the upper Beavertoe
