Tuesday 23

Self busy packing boxes down to the bank. The arrival at noon and landed for a short time then continued on her way. The apputer & Mrs. McQueen and a few others left on boat. Mr. McDougall up Hope was also a passenger. Very cold last night a light frost. A few of the potatoes were frozen.

Wednesday 24

a fine clear day self in store very little doing. Cadanhand & Brady arrived from Hope.

Thursday 25

Continued fine. Self & George went up and brought the mowen & Rabe to the top of the Hill when we intended putting up some hay.

Friday 26

George started to cut hay on top of the Hill. Self at oil press around the place. 2 men arrived looking up at cattle range.

Saturday 27

a fine clear day self took a Rabe up the Hill and put the Rabe together. Hay looks fine.

Sunday 28

a fine clear day had a visit from Mr & Mrs Ogilvie up at the house.
