all day but did not rain  
Prison falling fast

Sunday 11

a fine warm day the Police & Clark  
and George visiting around  
all day as they are leaving for the  
front on Tuesday. Angus went  
up to the Hay Camp to help Jim  
Woodward 3 Indians arrived  
from the north

Monday 12

The Indians left this morning  
The O A Thomas arrived with a  
lot of passengers for H. Hays Mr Boyd  
the boss of this Detachment Board  
and they all started on their  
way to H. Hays a fine clear day

Tuesday 13

Self on store the Great arrived  
this evening from H. H. and took on  
hand 3 men says one of them  
also Clark & the Chief ~~convinced~~  
bound for Vancouver. to be trained

Wednesday 14

Self went out to Hay Camp  
the finished at the prison and  
started over to Johny place  
to cut out & build up new house  
put up 40 heads Hay

Thursday 15

Rain this morning I went up  
to Hay Camp at noon the boys  
cut the barley at Johny place  
after dinner and then cut some Hay

Friday 16

2 Prospector arrived from up  
the Nelson River and found some  
good prospects of silver & copper  
self in office Mr Richardson left this  
morning with a crew for P. H.
